



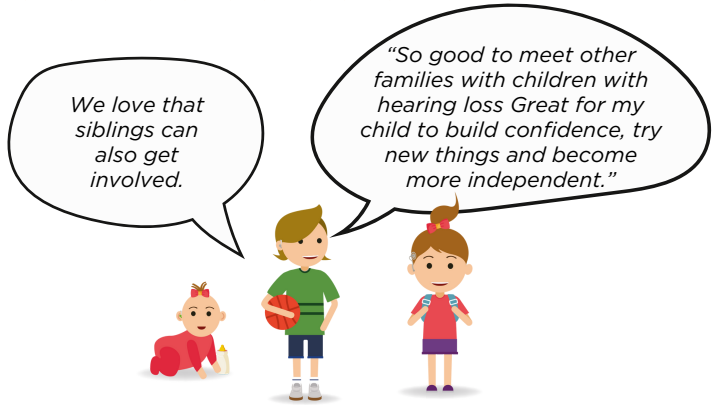
OUR IMPACT 2024

Since 2020, Hear Together has worked with d/Deaf children, teenagers and adults across Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire. Our aim is to help people live well with hearing loss. We believe that connecting and communicating with other people is fundamental to living well, so our services bring people and community together.

We ran fun monthly events for d/Deaf children from babies to teenagers. Our new in-school workshops are building knowledge, awareness, confidence and community. We created a Young Leaders programme for 16-25 year olds to learn new skills and take on the next challenge.

Free local hearing aid support!

Our free Hear2Help service provided **85** drop-in community clinics helping **756** people to keep wearing their hearing aids and stay connected to their family and friends.

85 clinics provided **756 hearing aids checked**

Specialist training for professionals & bespoke Deaf Awareness

170 people gained new skills and confidence

We ran **8 specialist courses** for professionals working with d/Deaf children & Deaf Awareness training for organisations.

Our team of 6 each work up to one day a week. We all have professional or lived experience of deafness and are passionate about what we do.

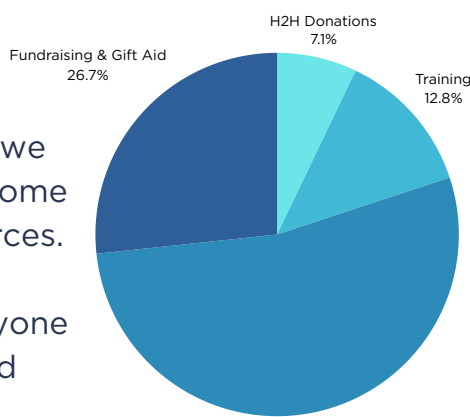
We recruited **3 new volunteers** and **6 Young Leaders** this year.
